There is to be a social event this Monday at which it is hoped more prospective members will join, thereby providing the number of members suitable for Charter.

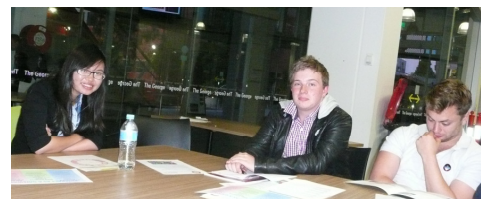
